



JOB DESCRIPTION

For the position of

AQUATIC INSTRUCTORS



SWIM INSTRUCTOR:

- Barcroft Beach Swim Instructors are directly responsible for ensuring that developmentally appropriate swim level standards are met and that all skills are properly taught. These individuals must hold certification as a Water Safety Instructor or Basic Swimming Instructor with the American Red Cross, or an equivalent learn to swim program recognized by the Commonwealth of Virginia. In addition, this individual must clear a Child Abuse and Criminal Background Screening as well as have the ability to directly lead and supervise swim instructor aides. This individual is expected to be capable of demonstrating all swimming strokes and techniques as well as possess the ability to plan and assess lesson groups of 3-15 students.

LIFEGUARD INSTRUCTOR:

- Barcroft Beach Lifeguard Instructors should be fully trained and certified for the open water lifeguard position as stipulated in the Waterfront Beach Lifeguard Job Description. Lifeguard instructors will work with the Water Safety Supervisor to provide swim instruction and basic lifesaving skills to students that range in age and skill level. The Lifeguard Instructor must be at least 18 years or older and will need to clear a Child Abuse and Criminal Background Screening. Lifeguard Instructors are directly responsible for ensuring that standards are met and that all training modules are taught by persons with proper credentials. This job requires the applicant to provide a quality learning experience for all students and assure their safety while providing lifeguard instruction.

JR. LIFEGUARD INSTRUCTOR:

- JR Lifeguard Instructors are expected to plan and coordinate safety activities or games for groups of children ages 11-14. These individuals will work under the direct supervision and direction of the Jr Lifeguard lead instructor. It is expected that JR Lifeguard Instructors possess current open water lifeguard credentials as described in the Barcroft Beach Lifeguard Handbook in accordance with the USLA standards for seasonal Open Water Lifeguards and demonstrate extensive knowledge of Lake Barcroft and Barcroft Beach Lifeguard operations. These individuals will need to clear a Child Abuse and Criminal Background Screening as well as be able to demonstrate ALL essential skills of an Open Water Lifeguard as identified by the USLA. It is expected that this individual will serve as an excellent mentor and role model for young aspiring lifeguards.
